Important Taste of the Town Safety Information for Parents: 2018

Please read the following information to assure your children's safety at this event.

Parents: Please check at the volunteer table and arrive at your designated station on time. It is important that you have arrangements for the care of your young children while you work. The Convention Center becomes very crowded with many strangers (over 10,000 last year!) and safety is a concern. We will talk to the students in class about proper behavior and safety procedures, but you can help by reinforcing this information.

- Students in 3rd grade and younger must be under adult supervision at all times.
- Students 4th grade and older, with parental permission only, may walk around the event with a buddy. They should stick together and not talk to people they do not know. They should also check in with you every 30 minutes.
- Absolutely **no running** in the Convention Center. If you see children running, please ask them to walk!
- We discourage the formation of large groups of students. They become noisy, unruly, and often do not watch where they are going. Staying with one good friend is the best idea.
- Encourage <u>polite</u>, <u>courteous behavior</u>. We are all representing St. Andrew Catholic School and need to extend hospitality and consideration for others.
- The DJ stage is a popular location. The students may dance or sit and listen, but they <u>may not sit on</u> <u>the edge of the stage.</u>
