The App allows live streaming, meaning people can interact with your child, and it allows direct messaging used by many as text messaging. We bring this to your attention only to share information with you. Sometimes seemingly innocent Apps still need to be monitored by parents.

Directly below that you will have a choice of days. Scroll down to "date range" and enter the applicable range. If you need this report for 2018 tax purposes, then your date range will probably be 01/01/2018 to 12/31/2018. Then under "All Accounts" choose "Child Care". There is a button on the top right to "Print". Please note that the school's Federal ID number will be printed on the first page.
