The scholarship application form is open and will also close on March 29. *Instructional Fees will be drafted out of your accounts on April 26, 2019.*

ATTENTION EXCEPTIONAL NEEDS APPLICATNS: Applications will be open from Friday, March 1, 2019 at 12 noon until Tuesday, April 30, 2019 at 5 pm. Students who currently have an AAP, have a diagnosed learning difference or have applied for this grant in the past should apply for this State Grant.
