Welcome to the 2019-2020 school year! Healthy children learn better! As your school nurses, our primary goal is to support your child's learning. We are available to provide support to you and your child's physician by providing preventative services, early identification of medical problems, and treatment of illness and injury during the school day.

The school nursing office is staffed by a Registered Nurse Monday thru Friday from 11a-1p. The nursing office is not staffed on half days. Over the counter and prescription medications require medical authorization forms for administration. As a reminder, students may not carry OTC or prescription medications on their person or in their backpacks, including cough drops. All medical forms are located on our school website.
