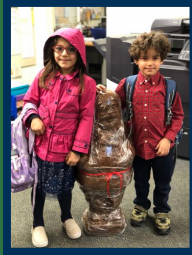


CHOCOLATE Santa FOR EVERYONE!

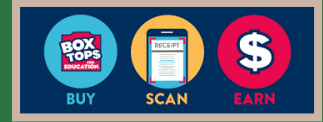
