- **Registration for 2020-2021 School Year is in progress!** At this time, instructional fees are delayed until June 15<sup>th</sup>, but everyone is welcome to register now. There will not be an increase in tuition for 2020-2021, and we are going to a **12 month payment schedule** as opposed to the 10 month payment schedule we are currently using. No incidentals for March were charged to your account.

(Rain date: June 2<sup>nd</sup>)
- K-7 supply drop-off/pick up is June 1<sup>st</sup>. A checklist of items your teachers expect to be returned along with directions and a schedule with your family's time has been sent in an email from Mrs. Lewis. On June 1<sup>st</sup> you will come to the school parking lot to drop off all school issued supplies and pick up any supplies left at school. Rain date: June 4<sup>th</sup>. Please make note of the schedule and plan to be on time. Thank you!
