Thank you to 2nd grade, who won the contest in the lower school by collecting 2,659 cans. 8th grade won in the middle school collecting 1,000 cans with 7th grade on their heels with 828 cans. 5th grade had 1,161 cans with 100% class participation, and 4th grade met and exceeded their challenge with 632 cans.
