- Ordination of our new Bishop: Bishop elect Jacques E. Fabre CS will be ordained and installed on Friday, May 13, 2022. Vespers will be held on May 12 at 6:00 pm. As part of this momentous occasion, all Catholic Schools in the diocese are excused from school on the ordination day, May 13. There will be no school on Friday, May 13, and all students, parents and staff are encouraged to pray for our new Bishop and to watch the ordination livestream.
