



Policy for Virtual School Students

Virtual School is provided for students who are home with an extended illness or as a result of medical procedures. This program is intended for students who are well enough to complete the course work at home.

- Parents are to email or call the office if a student will not report to school due to illness by 9:00 am. The student will receive an excused absence and will rest for the day.
- Parents are to pick up books and materials in the front office between 3:00 and 4:00 pm on the first day of absence if it is anticipated that the student will be out more than one day.
- Using school-issued iPads, students may virtual into classrooms on the second day of their absence if they have the appropriate materials.
- Students must be in the complete school uniform.
- Students must be in full view of the camera and in a designated learning space.
- Students must let a teacher know if they need to leave the virtual classroom. Students are expected to be in the virtual classroom for the duration of the school day as if they were in the building.
- Work can be found on Google Classroom the day it is assigned.
- Prior to joining the virtual classroom, students should download and print work from Goggle Classroom in order to be ready for the school day.
- Teachers will help students make up work upon their return to school.
