WE ARE STEM CERTIFIED!

e are excited to announce St. Andrew Catholic School has earned STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) certification through Cognia[®]! A Cognia[®] accreditation signifies that a school meets or exceeds rigorous standards of educational quality and effectiveness, which enhance the institution's credibility and the academic preparation of its students. Cognia[®] is a global accrediting agency recognized by the State Departments of Education and the United States Department of Education. St. Andrew and the Catholic schools under the umbrella of the Diocese of Charleston have earned accreditation, but now St. Andrew has gone another step above and beyond!

Cognia[®] STEM Certification evaluates whether and how a school or program has built a STEM learning system that embodies the practices and characteristics of a quality, relevant, and age appropriate STEM education. St. Andrew Catholic School has been working on not only STEM, but STREAM certification since before COVID-19. In addition to the disciplines of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics, our school integrated Religion and the Arts into our review process because our school is built on our faith, and the arts are integrated across grade levels and subject areas. The report detailed our Butterfly Garden project, the Communities Around the World project, which took place in the spring of 2023, our musicals, the integration of faith throughout the curriculum, and how the arts are integrated across subject areas. The Cognia[®] team reviewed an extensive report presented by our faculty, and then several stakeholders were interviewed on May 7 for the final phase of the accreditation process. These stakeholders included teachers, parents, students, and our Advisory Board. The Cognia[®] reviewers were most impressed with our students and their report of our school!

Thank you to all of our teachers, staff, parents, and students, who diligently worked to make this a reality for our school. We are dedicated to STREAM certification as it is another illustration of how we 'Know and Love' each of our students, providing a quality and diverse education rooted in problem solving and the foundation of our faith.




