Communicate with Respect

- Speak with kindness, patience, and courtesy at all times.
- Use a constructive tone in emails, phone calls, and meetings.
- Avoid criticism of staff, students, or families, especially in public or on social media.

Follow the Right Channels

- For classroom or academic concerns: Contact the teacher first.
- For unresolved issues: Request a meeting with the principal or designated staff.
- Allow at least 24–48 hours for responses to emails or messages.
- Please respect instructional time, drop-ins during class are prohibited.

Maintain Professionalism & Privacy

- Keep conversations and concerns confidential.
- Avoid speaking about other students or families.
- Respect that some information may not be shared due to privacy policies.
